- 1. Owen Kearney discussed the 3<sup>rd</sup> rezoning phase. The City is hoping to complete the project by Spring 2018. Much is eliminating erratic zoning so more development can be possible. It will require legislative approval.
- 2. \$350K RFP for Creek walk from Armory Square West to Midland. Will need to acquire properties in the Colvin St Area.
