Issues for City Departments

Skateboarders are out again, making ramps with bricks

8 out of 10 cars fail to stop at the corner of Solar and Plum St.

Sgt. Hillman stated that his administration wanted him to update the community that retired Police officers have been hired to live monitor the COPS cameras that are located throughout the city. There are currently no cameras in the Lakefront area.

- Q. Are the Police wearing Body cams yet?
- A. No, not yet but they will be coming out soon. There will only be 10 to start as a pilot program. Logistics and Policy behind downloading, reviewing, when to review needs to be figured out.
- Q. Do other departments already use them?>
- A. Yes, but it takes 10-15 min to download footage at the end of the shift.
- Q. You wouldn't review them unless there's an issue, correct?
- A. Right.
- Q. What would be a good example of reviewing prior to incident?
- A. People live monitoring might see large crowd (in problematic areas) and watch the activity.
- Q. What's the process of getting cops on problem site?
- A. A 911 call will initiate their attention to an area to look at the live camera footage. Assemblyman Magnarelli lobbied for funding for the COPS cameras, which cost around \$10,000 each.

Juanita Perez Williams stated that no one questions using the cameras to prosecute criminal activity. It becomes a slippery slope when watching to watch activity in an area.
