

## TNT Valley January 10, 2018 Minutes

Approval of the November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2017 meeting Minutes: George Matthews motioned to approve the minutes as written, Bob Dougherty 2<sup>nd</sup>, all were in favor.

### Government Departments:

- I. City Police: Officer Corcoran distributed a crime map of the Valley.
- II. County Issues: Ryan McMahon, County Legislature, informed the group that the Speed Reader purchased by the County has been removed for the winter months by the State DOT. It will be put back in place in the Spring time.
- III. Councilor Sue Boyle informed the group of a recent School Board approval of a preferential hiring policy for City residents. Councilor Boyle also discussed the conversations between the City and County to assist homeowners in addressing the sediment issues of the environmentally protected streams located on their properties. The Council has discussed making sidewalk legislation a priority. There was contamination found in the soil of the Mobil Station property; the City is working with the State to address this issue.

Committee Reports: Kathy Stribley, Beautification & Planning, provided an update on the LouJane Market.

### Presentations/Discussion:

- I. Special Projects: Carl Sharak and Tina Zagyva, TNT Coordinator, discussed the Special Projects process and potential ideas for proposals.
- II. Seneca Turnpike Project: Russ Houck, project engineer, provided an overview of the Seneca Turnpike improvement project.

TNT City-Wide Update: Tina Zagyva informed the members of a recent 2 page document approved by the TNT City-Wide Board indicating the roles and responsibilities of Facilitators, Task Forces, Coordinator and Board members. Ms. Zagyva also outlined the discussion regarding the relationship between TNT and the City's new administration. It was mentioned that TNT potentially has the opportunity to be a part of a newly developed Quality of Life Commission through the City.
