Three projects were present to the TNT Board for funding consideration.

Maren King asked that a spokesperson for their project give a brief overview of their project and its funding. Projects under consideration were;

Eric Ennis - \$4,000 Adopt CNY, Inc. Public Art Task Force is seeking funds to Create an artwork installation program along the Onondaga Creek walk.

Gary Crawford - \$2,900 **Build IT and They will Sail IT**. Provide stipends for 4 students, pay teachers/leader of the construction, purchase life/flotation vests for new sailors sail making material and support materials.

Maren King - \$1,360 Creekwalk Plantings. Labor Costs for a Program Coordinator with young adults assisting. To replace existing plants that did not survived due to watering issues. Purchasing new plants, fertilizer/compost along with mulch.

The Board after long deliberations, with further review of each individual project, reached a decision that deemed fair and equitable based on current need and funds available.

The final awards are as follows;

\$1,000 Adopt CNY Inc.

\$2,770 Build IT and They will Sail It

\$1,230 Creekwalk Plantings

Maren King made a motion to fund the three projects as agreed upon.
