Ms. Deacon provided an overview of the recently passed NYS budget. Questions were taken from the floor.

Special Projects Funds: Ed Morris was awarded funds for a Spring Fling event; there is \$80 remaining. Ed proposed using the remaining funds to purchase a banner advertising the Northside TNT. Gerry Scott motioned to approve spending the funds on the banner, John Meyer 2nd. All were in favor.

TNT City-wide Board Delegate Update: Pat Body, Chair of the City-wide Board, stated that TNT officers of the board will be attending all sector TNT meetings to discuss the structure and policies of TNT. The Mayor has committed to funding TNT fiscal year 2018-2019, however, the following year is uncertain.
