Joe Cecile, Deputy Chief of Police & Richard Shoff, Deputy Chief of Community Policing:

Mr. Cecile and Mr. Shoff took questions from the floor in regards to guns, problematic youth and drugs. Call tip 411 to report any concerns or potential hot spots.

S.O.S. (Supporting Our Students) is a collaborative program between the SCSD and Police Department; youths who have experienced a traumatic event and then have to attend school the following day are provided additional support. Members identified the need for youth employment during nights and weekends as well as directing youths to these opportunities. There are a little over 400 cameras installed throughout the City; there will be additional cameras installed in the near future. Funding has been secured for 150 – 200 body cameras.

Special Projects: Gerry Scott provided an overview of the Special Projects. Deadline to submit proposals is January 31st. Proposals will be discussed and voted upon at the February meeting. Two restrictions have been added to the guidelines: project proposals cannot include purchase of personal property or monetary gifts to other organizations.
