- **Washington Square Task Force** is requesting **\$1,000** for the annual Easter event
- **Mary Salibrici** is requesting **\$1,000** for the annual Northside Festival
- **Washington Square Task Force** is requesting **\$1,000** for the annual Holiday event

5) Sue Lewis: Blocks in Bloom Program

Blocks in Bloom is a program designed to start small flower gardens in front lawns in city neighborhoods; the program is looking for city blocks where 6 or more residences are interested in planting flowers in their front lawns, as well as maintaining the beds by watering and weeding.

6) Adria Finch: Startup in Residence (STIR)

The Office of Accountability, Performance and Innovation is hosting community meetings to help brainstorm ideas for a list of community activities that people can participate in. These activities will be geared at reducing (or avoiding violence), and helping others who have been exposed to some type of trauma.
