# Rezone Update: Owen Kerney, Assistant Director of City Planning

The City's zoning (land use regulation) was last updated in 1967. The City received a grant to update the zoning and will roll out a final draft of the new ordinance in the near future. There were five goals in the initiative: Creating a user friendly ordinance (charts, tables, graphs, simplify language), Update the zoning districts (15 residential/mixed use/commercial/open spaces), Modernizing land uses, Design standards, Streamlining and updating the review process.
