**Special Projects:** Mike Parzych's previously approved project will not be able to be funded this fiscal year. The project was not approved by the Parks Department as it is underfunded to meet safety regulations. ## Rezone Update: Owen Kerney, Assistant Director of City Planning

The City's zoning (land use regulation) was last updated in 1967. The City received a grant to update the zoning and will roll out a final draft of the new ordinance in the near future. There were five goals in the initiative: Creating a user friendly ordinance (charts, tables, graphs, simplify language), Update the zoning districts (15 residential/mixed use/commercial/open spaces), Modernizing land uses, Design standards, Streamlining and updating the review procedures.
