

Meeting Minutes: September 11th, 2019**Facilitator:** Marilyn Madison

Public Officials: Captain Lynch and Lt. Mahar presented a crime report map. Questions were taken from the floor. The CRB holds open public meeting the first Thursday of each month at 5:30pm in the Council Chambers where cases are reviewed; meetings are also livestreamed on youtube.
