Meeting called to order at 7:02pm

January 22nd Meeting Minutes: Gerry Scott motioned to approve the minutes as written, Chris Bianchi 2nd, all were in favor.**Facilitator Elections:** Ed Morris was elected by majority vote; 12 votes yes.**Issues for Elected Officials/City Departments:** Lt. Brian Williams provided a crime report. The E-serve and Tele-serve programs were described; syracusepolice.org e-serve link. Questions were taken from the floor. Councilor Hogan and Councilor Carni addressed questions related to the SPD contract.**Syracuse Land Bank:** Shavel Edwards, *Community Engagement Specialist* with the Land Bank, provided a demonstration of the Land Banks new website interface. Handouts were distributed regarding statistics on properties that are vacant and those that were sold.**Special Projects Presentation and Vote:** Each TNT sector has a total of \$5,000 for community building capital enhancement projects or community building events. Only those who live, work or own property within the Northside sector are eligible to vote.

Chris Bianchi motioned to approve projects 1, 2, 3, 5 as proposed and to approve project 4 in the amount of \$1,200 as well as the remaining balance of \$184. Gerry Scott 2nd, all were in favor.**TNT City-wide Update:** Tina Zagya stated that the TNT dance party raised \$2,000; all proceeds will go towards city-wide initiatives. TNT will also have a float in the Saint Patrick's day parade, all are welcome to join.**Announcements:**
