Meeting Minutes: March 11th, 2020

<u>Approval of February 12th, 2020 Minutes:</u> George Matthews motioned to approve the minutes, Dee Klees 2nd, all were in favor.

<u>Public Officials</u>: Captain Lynch distributed a crime analysis handout. County Legislator Bill Kinne stated that there will be discussion to 'ok' a beach at Onondaga Lake at a cost of 3 million; projected annual maintenance cost hasn't been determined. Councilor Rudd provided an update on the new lead law and Rezone. Questions were taken from the floor.

Brittany Taylor, Sankofa Wellness Resource Center: Ms. Taylor stated that the wellness center is at 2323 South Salina Street. The center works in partnership with the food bank and offers peer services to address things such as mental health issues, substance abuse, etc. The center is also a Food Sense location; healthy food packages once a month available to any income level. There is a personal care pantry and diaper bank located at the center. 9am – 5pm walk-in Monday through Friday. There is programming each month. Questions were taken from the floor.

<u>TNT City-wide Updates:</u> Marilyn Madison stated that TNT will have a float in the Saint Patrick's Day Parade on Saturday, March 14th, all are welcome to join.

<u>Committee Updates</u>: Beautification Committee stated that a bench purchased through TNT funds last year has been destroyed by snow plows.

Special Project revisions: Dorothy Matthews requested a change to her senior party proposal: rather than host one party at \$300, the seniors would like to split it up into two parties for \$150 each. Carl Sharak motioned to approve the revision, Caroline West 2nd, all were in favor. A question was asked in regards to the accessibility of the senior parties to the general senior public; expanded notification should be taken into consideration if this project is proposed next fiscal year.
