Issues for Elected Officials/City Departments: Councilor Carni answered questions in regards to a corner store; the permit was denied. Councilor Hogan provided an update on a convenience store on the corner of Spring St. and LeMoyne Ave. Questions were taken from the floor.

Housing Visions, Moyers Carriage Lofts: Mike LaFlair, *Director of Community & Government Relations*, provided an update on the project. There will be a total of 128, 1 or 2 bedroom units. Questions were taken from the floor.

Northside Crime & Safety Discussion: SPD Quadrant lines

Hon. Khalid Bey, *Councilor at Large*, Hon. Michael Greene, *Councilor at Large*, Hon. Pat Hogan, *2nd District Councilor*, Hon. Joe Carni, *1st District Councilor*. Residents expressed concern over a rise in violent crime on the Northside and the large area the quadrant covers as per the Police quadrant lines. It was requested that the North quadrant be broken into two: The Northeast and the Northwest. Discussion ensued.

It was suggested that a committee be formed to look into locations to host youth activities in the evening. Mary Salibric and Syeisha offered to organize the committee.

Pat Body outlined the meetings for the next few months; February will have representatives from the Center for Community Alternatives, Judges, and a discussion on the Bail reform legislation and how it affects the Northside. The March meeting we will have the Mayor and the Chief of Police.
