**City as Canvas:** The Dalevan has been selected by the Syracuse Public Art Commission as the most viable location for the Westside mural program. Hilary Donohue made a motion to approve the Delavan building wall located at the intersection of Niagara and West Fayette St. as the first mural location on the Westside, Rick Destito seconded, all were in favor. TNT will issue a call for art at this location and submissions will be reviewed at the April meeting.
