City as Canvas:

Tina Zagyva, TNT Operations Manager, provided an overview of the City as Canvas initiative, funded by the American Rescue Plan Act through the office of the Mayor. Each of the three local artists who submitted their design concepts for the Downtown TNT Jazz Central (441 E. Washington Street) mural location, presented their design concepts and took questions from the floor. A ranked-choice ballot was distributed to the voting members in attendance. Those who qualify to vote must either live, work or own property within the Downtown TNT sector. Postcard ballots were also distributed to local Downtown residents, employees within City Hall as well as various businesses surrounding the Jazz Central building. The top choice will be announced via email on the following week.
