TNT Downtown and Lakefront Meeting Minutes

<u>Call to Order:</u> Eric Saxton welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 5:35 pm. He invited the attendees to introduce themselves to the group.

<u>Ground Rules:</u> Eric Saxton briefly went over the established ground rules for online TNT meetings.

<u>Draft Meeting Minutes for February 15, 2023</u>: Conor Rockhill motioned to approve the minutes, Bill Lee seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

<u>Issues for District Representatives/Elected Officials/City Departments</u>: There were no representatives from City Departments present.

<u>TNT City-Wide Director's Update</u>: Matt will share information about rezoning and changes in trash collection when he receives it.

<u>City as Canvas:</u> Jimmy Monto will contact the Parks Commissioner to ask the new Trails Coordinator to meet with Lakefront residents to see if there is a location on the Creek Walk for the sector's mural.

<u>Special Projects:</u> Downtown increased one previously submitted project by \$500 and submitted four new \$500 special projects for consideration including support for:

- 1. Meals on Wheels Alley Cat Ride Kitchen Sponsor
- 2. Hanover Thursdays Community Sponsor
- 3. Downtown Farmers Market Friends of the Market Sponsor
- 4. Sunrise Yoga

Eric Saxton made a motion to approve the submitted proposals and Conor Rockhill seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The Common Council will vote on Special Projects in mid-April. Funding is not available until after the vote. Matt fielded questions and shared a link to information about how to submit invoices so that people can become familiar with the process.

Sector Social - Downtown and Lakefront sectors are planning a joint sector social to raise awareness of TNT and provide an opportunity for neighbors to meet each other. The target date is June 14. We are looking for a place to host and have floated The Preserve as a possibility due to its proximity to both sectors. Other suggestions are welcome. Details will be ironed out by the May meeting.

Announcements and Discussion:

The Downtown Committee will host its annual Earth Day Cleanup on Saturday April 22. Details will be forthcoming. Dining Week ends today.

There was a discussion about whether the Downtown-Lakefront TNT meetings would return to in person format. Several people noted that for a variety of reasons, more people attend the Zoom meetings. This could change in the future.

The next regularly scheduled meeting will be May 17, 2023.
