Give Yourself Piece of Mind Booklet – planning ahead for when you are not able to make decisions for yourself. Listing of meal sites for Onondaga County residents 60 and over and their spouses. There are no income requirements per se, there is a suggested contribution (voluntary). Funded by Title3b funds.

Office for Aging – funding is from the federal government, NYS, and City of Syracuse, Onondaga County Legislature, and any grants that can be written. Most services provided are from local nonprofits. Health Insurance information is provided for free. NOT sales but information only.

Assistance applying for HEAP is available. HEAP opens November 1<sup>st</sup>. Community services such as shopping services, nutrition services such as Meals on Wheels, Nutrition Counseling, Registered Dieticians are available. Nurses are available to go into the home to gauge whether a person needs a nursing home, assisted living, etc.

Adult protective services- 18 years of age and older – referrals are assigned to a case worker. Guardianships can be assigned to help provide safety and stability.
