<u>Call to Order:</u> Bill Lee welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 5:38 pm. He invited the attendees to introduce themselves to the group.

<u>Ground Rules:</u> Bill Lee briefly went over the established ground rules for online TNT meetings.

<u>Draft Meeting Minutes for January 19, 2023</u>: Eric Saxton motioned to approve the minutes, Conor Rockhill seconded, and the motion passed as written.

<u>Issues for District Representatives/Elected Officials/City Departments:</u>

Captain Bowering of the Syracuse Police Department asked if people had noticed an uptick in issues on the Creekwalk due to warmer weather. - 4. Beautify 331 South Salina

Downtown has funds leftover and must get proposals for how to spend the remainder to Matt in the next week. There will be an opportunity to review the new proposals and vote online. Several people asked clarifying questions and made suggestions for projects including a memorial garden, music, and other events.

Announcements:

There will be a new meeting schedule for the Downtown-Lakefront sectors. We will meet in the odd months (January, March, May, July, September, November) on the third Wednesday of the month beginning with the next meeting. We can schedule additional meetings (like the one customarily held in February to vote on special projects) as needed. We hope this will be an easier schedule for everyone to follow.
