<u>Erie Blvd Empire Trail Project:</u> Frank Brosch, DOT Construction Supervisor, updated the members on the Erie Blvd. project. Over 1,000 trees and shrubs will be plants, and the monument will be refurbished and re-labeled. The entire trail system through Syracuse will be finished by the end of this year. Questions were taken from the floor.

<u>Common Council Redistricting</u>: Hon. Helen Hudson, *President of the Common Council,* Dustin Czarny, *Elections Commissioner*

President Hudson will be undergoing a process to appoint community members to be a part of the commission. These Commissioners will be barred from running for office for 5 years for the district lines they have drawn. Once the Commission draws the map, the council will have to adopt the new district map. A timeline for the panel selection was provided. Questions were taken from the floor.

<u>TNT City-wide Board Director Update:</u> Ken Garno stated that the TNT board has revised the bylaws to appoint board directors in inactive sectors; John Levick has been appointed for the Lakefront sector.

<u>Census 2020 Update:</u> Ken Garno stated that the supreme court ruled this day that the current administration can end the Census count earlier than the October 31st deadline.
