Issue for City Departments/Elected Officials/District Representatives: Tina Zagyva, TNT Operations Manager, stated that the SPD will not be attending TNT meetings due to budget cuts; they will work on sending the sectors a crime data report prior to the monthly meetings.

<u>Common Council Redistricting</u>: Hon. Helen Hudson, President of the Common Council Hon. Pat Hogan, 2ndDistrict Councilor, Dustin Czarny Elections Commissioner

The Council is currently working on enabling legislation to move the legislation to vote on. President Hudson will be undergoing a process to appoint community members to be a part of the commission (15 members). These Commissioners will be barred from running for office for 5 years for the district lines they have drawn. Once the Commission draws the map, the council will have to adopt the new district map. A timeline for the panel selection was provided.

Special Projects: Robb Bucklin requested to repurpose his two Special Project proposals totaling \$900, to be used for a garden project in collaboration with the Downtown TNT for the 'Welcome to Downtown' on the corner of West Genesee and Tracy Street. The project funds will be used to install the garden at the signage. Hilary motioned to approve the change in funding, Michelle 2^{nd} , all were in favor.
