<u>Special Projects:</u> The Eastwood sector has \$300 in remaining Special Project funding. Chief of Police, Joe Cecile:

Chief Cecile provided a brief overview of his history with the Police force. Nuisance properties were discussed. Neighborhood watch groups have increased citywide; many do not want to list themselves on the city website due to various reasons. Firework season is coming up, there are specific firework details ready to go during the busy season such as July. (Judges will often dismiss fireworks tickets). ATV's/motorbikes cannot be chased by the police. Air force one follows them by air and then Police are able to confiscate the illegal vehicles. The only way they can be retrieved is by paying a heavy fine due to legislation passed by the common council last year. The Police Athletic League offers programming for youth in the evening hours and on the weekends; basketball, soccer, volleyball, etc. Chief Cecile cell number is 315-263-6129.
