Present: Dan Romeo, Jimmy Monto, Principal of Huntington, Director of Neighbors and Businesses

We opened it up to comments and questions.

Jim: Why wouldn't SPD buy their new building instead of renting? Jimmy - there is no rent option.

Mike: Why isn't Eastwood parks getting free wifi? Jimmy - they will eventually, they are starting in areas where the least wifi access currently exists per the census tracts.

Police Stats:

Violent crime overall continues to decrease

For example, Eastwood had zero murders in 2023.

Rape, robbery, assault, etc, all even or down.

Motor vehicle theft is up big, 185%

In 2024, SPD will put more effort in quality of life and property crimes - currently criminals are targeting commercial properties. Owners please help by securing buildings, use lighting and cameras.

Biggest police calls in Eastwood from residents:

Vehicle issues

Property checks

Follow-up investigations

Traffic Issues

Biggest Eastwood arrests in 2023 was domestic related

Hot spot is area near grant village

Stolen vehicles everywhere in eastwood and CNY.

New cameras that can result in tickets are coming to James Street by schools: Blessed Sacrament and Lincoln.

Questions for officer:

-We want to see data from 20-30 years ago to compare beyond the 5 year average

-Can we put lights on a mobile traffic sign and move around the area? Officer not sure

-Sunnycrest golf clubhouse was broken into twice by kids. What's happening? Not current leads. They drove golf carts around causing damage.

-Can we hold parents more accounts for the crimes committed by kids? No, we need change at the state level. Officer praised the city government's efforts and attitude.

-We need more focus on odd/even parking. Officer said call/text him or Jimmy Monto with location and will get out there.

-Do police come to car accidents anymore? No, not if there is no injuries. You can file police report online, but they are reducing their visits to civic issues like a car accident to folk efforts elsewhere.
