<u>September 25th Meeting Minutes</u>: Katie Scott motioned to approve the minutes as written, Chris Bianchi 2nd, all were in favor.

Issues for Elected Officials/City Departments: Officer Williams provided a crime analysis for the Northside. Questions were taken from the floor. Shavel Edwards, with the Greater Syracuse Land Bank took questions from the floor.

Facilitator Elections: Gerry explained the nominations process; ballots were distributed to the voting members in attendance. Ed Morris requested to be removed from the ballot. 16 ballots were collected, all were elected by majority vote; Judy Scheuer, Jay Subedi, Pat Body, Gerry Scott, Chris Bianchi and Syeisha Byrd. Katie Scott nominated Anthony Correia, Ed Morris Sr. 2nd, all were in favor.

Census 2020 Education & Awareness: Chris Ivens, Partnership Specialist NY Regional Office. Mr. Ivens provided an overview of the Census mission: Count everyone once, only once and in the right place so that the correct information is delivered to the Office of the President. All Census information gathered is confidential and will only be used to produce statistics for funding distributed from the federal government (\$675 Billion) based on populations. <u>www.census.gov</u> In March of 2020, individuals will be sent a card in the mail with an invitation code to fill out the Census questionnaire online; if people do not respond via internet, they will receive a paper version with the option to call in by phone. Questions were taken from the floor. Ken Garno stated that TNT has been assigned the neighborhoods as part of the City's Complete Count initiative and is operating under a grant from the CNY Community Foundation.

TNT City-wide Update: Pat Body stated that the TNT sector receives \$5,000 each year for Special Projects. Proposals are due by January 31st, 2020; these can be sent via email, postal mail or in person to the TNT office.
