All Census information gathered is confidential and will only be used to produce statistics for funding distributed from the federal government (\$675 Billion) based on populations. <u>www.census.gov</u> In March of 2020, individuals will be sent a card in the mail with an invitation code to fill out the Census questionnaire online; if people do not respond via internet, they will receive a paper version with the option to call in by phone. Questions were taken from the floor. Ken Garno stated that TNT has been assigned the neighborhoods as part of the City's Complete Count initiative.

<u>Committee Updates</u>: Kathy Stribley stated that the Planning Committee is still dealing with the flooding issue; there is misinformation regarding the water and streams effecting the valley.

<u>TNT City-wide Board Updates</u>: Marilyn Madison stated that Ken Garno has done a huge amount of work regarding the Census initiative.
