Special Projects Update: Tina Zagyva, Operations Manager, provided the special projects update regarding remaining funding for last fiscal years project funds.

Lisa Lambert stated that the pieces for the gaga pits are ready for assembly; they will be built over the next few weeks. Kathy Stribley stated that there are beautification funds available at Chuck Hafners; there has not been much planting this summer due to the dry weather and the limited ability for volunteers to water the plants.
