<u>Committee Updates</u>: Kathy Stribley, beautification and planning committees, stated that she has been in conversation with the codes department regarding the corner of Orlando and South Salina. Kathy requested folks to help her maintain the Welcome sign plantings and maintenance.

Board Elections: Ballots were distributed to the eligible voting members in attendance. Joe Bennett and Lisa Lambert were elected by majority vote.

TNT City-wide Update: Tina Zagyva, TNT Operations Manager, stated that TNT is requesting the community to help identify locations for murals within the Valley neighborhood for the City as Canvas program.
