Draft Meeting minutes June 22, 2022: Ed Morris motioned to approve the minutes, Pat Hogan seconded, all were in favor.**Issus for District Representatives/City Departments/Elected Officials:**

Hon. Hogan stated that the nuisance abatement ordinance has been adjusted; the penalty fines have been increased from \$2,000 to \$10,000 and federal offenses have been rolled into the ordinance. Jake Dishaw, Commissioner of Codes, provided an update on problematic stores on the Northside as well as how to report code violations within your neighborhood.

Pat Hogan advocating for the neighborhoods.
