6:43 Call to order

6:45 Motion to approve meeting minutes. (Bill Kinne spelled incorrectly) George and Joe 2nd

6:46 Capt. Bowering SPD – Update on crime statistics – make sure you are locking your vehicles and keeping valuables out of sight. Hyundai/Kia Tik Tok challenge has hit the area. Questions were asked and answered from the audience.

6:54 Chol Majok – redistricting will be taking place. The Valley will be split into different sections. BRT (Bus Rapid Transit) Pilot 2026 Bus line will run from Eastwood to OCC. Police contract is up, they are looking to redo the contract. 4 10 hour days instead of 5 8 hour days.

7:02 Committee Updates Kathy Stribley – rezoning issues and deforestation. Public process was not followed. Parcel went from R1 to R4 without a process being followed. It was changed via Chol Majok, owner, and zoning. A resolution has been created. Chol Majok spoke about the situation. The owner stated he would like to develop the 4 acres of land with housing. A presentation and public hearing will take place. Making the parcel R4 allowed the developer to add senior housing and bring in tax revenue. The situation is not finalized yet. Conversation continued regarding the situation.

7:26 Special Projects Proposals – Presentations were made for projects. Voting took place following presentations. Special project for the Honoring Onondaga Creek Sculpture has been withdrawn. All projects have potential to be funded. Voting results – all projects voted in.
