7:03 Capt. Milano from SPD – crime update for the Northside – violent crime is up 23%. Mostly in the Butternut St corridor. Property crime is down in all categories except for larcenies. Motor vehicle thefts are up. SPD is actively recruiting new staff members.

7:19 Nick Pirro – NBD update on the Skyline apartments/Green Properties in Syracuse. The City has deemed the building unfit. They are pursuing a receivership of the property. The has offered \$1 million dollars to help remedy some of the issues.

7:24 Syracuse Fire Department – Tim Nelson – Fire Prevention The Syracuse Fire Dept is trying to make the City a safer place through education and free smoke detector distribution. There is a sign up sheet available to receive free smoke detectors/installation.

7:39 Mary Kuhn, County Legislature - spoke about the merger of the jail and Jamesville Penitentiary. Toby Shelly the new Sherriff was not included in the decision process. County Executive has stated he will move forward with decision, "he is the CEO of the County." More turn out is needed at public meetings to voice concerns.

7:47 Special Projects presentation and voting. 6 Projects were submitted, totalling \$7,499. All projects were approved with stipulations for the bench. There is a surplus of funds. We will accept submissions for the next few weeks to allocate the funds. Syeshia motion to approve mural, Karen second. Stipulation that Catherine and Burnet is part of Northside.
